- **2.** answer. Noun: something you say or write when someone asks you a question
- **3.** ask: Verb: to request an answer to a question
- 4. bake. Verb: to cook (food) in an oven using dry heat
- **5.** balls: Noun. A solid or hollow spherical or egg-shaped object that is kicked, thrown, or hit in a game.
- **6.** bandage: Noun. A strip of woven material used to bind up a wound or to protect an injured part of the body.
